## ORDER

On July 26, 1991, Salem Telephone Company ("Salem") filed a motion requesting a waiver of 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, and permitting it to use financial data outside the time frame for a test period.

807 KAR 5:001, Section 6, requires that whenever a financial exhibit is to be annexed to an application, it shall cover operations for a 12-month period ending not more than 90 days prior to the date the application is filed. However, this regulation does not apply to the time frame for the test period <u>per se</u> and therefore no Commission waiver on that issue is necessary.

At the time the Commission received Salem's application the financial exhibit met the 90-day requirement, and future monthly financial statement filings will serve to update this exhibit. Accordingly, the Commission, having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that Salem be granted a waiver from 807 KAR 5:001, Section 6.
