ORDER

On June 5, 1991, the Commission received from South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") a proposed tariff to offer Caller ID on a trial basis without the availability of a blocking option. On July 3, 1991, the Commission suspended the tariff for further investigation.

The Commission has addressed the issue of Caller ID previously in Case No. 90-096,¹ a tariff filing of GTE South Incorporated ("GTE South"). In that proceeding the Commission ordered free per call blocking to be offered with the provision of Caller ID. South Central Bell's proposed tariff does not contain a call blocking option. The Commission desires to have a uniform policy for the provision of Caller ID in the Commonwealth and will be reviewing its policy in this proceeding. Accordingly, GTE South should be made a party to this case.

Having been otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that GTE South be made a party to this proceeding and shall be served a copy of all pleadings.
