ORDER

On June 5, 1991, South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed a proposed tariff to introduce Caller ID on a market-trial basis. By Order dated July 3, 1991, the Commission suspended South Central Bell's proposed tariff for further investigation of its reasonableness. Intervenors in this proceeding are the Attorney General by and through his Utility and Rate Intervention Division; the American Civil Liberties Union of Kentucky; Lexington-Fayette County Urban Government; and additionally by Order of the Commission, GTE South, Inc.

The Commission, being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the following procedural schedule be established:

Comments of South Central Bell, including South Central Bell's rationale for proposing this tariff without free per call blocking and free per line blocking, shall be due	
no later than	09/13/91
Reply comments of Intervenors shall be due no later than	10/04/91
South Central Bell and Intervenors shall file a motion for hearing, if desired, and shall state specific issues to be addressed at such hearing	
no later than	10/71/01

If no motion for hearing has been received by October 21, 1991, this matter shall be submitted for decision without a public hearing.
