## ORDER

IT IS ORDERED that Clark Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Clark") shall file the original and six copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to all parties of record, within 20 days of the date of this Order. If the information cannot be provided by this date, Clark should submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which it will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission.

1. State the number of single phase meters which Clark must read annually to comply with 807 KAR 5:006, Section 6(5).

2. State the number of on-site meter readings Clark has taken annually for the years 1985-1990. (Meters which were read more than once annually should be counted as only one meter reading.)

3. (a) State whether Clark has ever read all meters annually.

(b) If Clark has ever read all meters annually, state:

(1) The number of employees required to perform this task.

(2) Whether the employees worked exclusively on this task.

(3) When this action was taken.

(4) Why this action was discontinued.

4. State whether Clark has commissioned or conducted any study to determine the extent of current diversion and under-reporting of electric usage. If such a study has been conducted, provide a copy.
