## ORDER

By application received July 15, 1991, Nelson Valley Water Association, Inc. ("Nelson Valley") requested a deviation from Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4), which provides that each utility shall provide water storage to ensure a minimum of one day's supply of its average daily water usage. Nelson Valley states in its application that its average daily water usage, including unaccounted-for water, is approximately 200,000 gallons, and that its current water storage capacity is 36,000 gallons.

The Commission, having reviewed the application and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

- 1. Nelson Valley is not in compliance with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4).
- 2. Because of the time needed to plan, finance, and implement a program to construct water storage facilities, Nelson Valley should be given until July 1, 1994 to bring it within compliance of Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4).

## IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Nelson Valley be and it hereby is given until July 1, 1994 to comply with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4).
- 2. Nelson Valley shall take all necessary actions to bring its water storage facilities into compliance with Commission regulations prior to July 1, 1994.
