This matter arising upon the motion of AmeriCall Systems of Louisville ("AmeriCall"), filed August 19, 1991 for full intervention, and it appearing to the Commission that AmeriCall has a special interest which is not otherwise adequately represented and that such intervention is likely to present issues and develop facts that will assist this Commission in fully considering the matters without unduly complicating or disrupting the proceedings, and this Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that:

1. The motion of AmeriCall to intervene is granted.
2. AmeriCall shall be entitled to the full rights of a party and shall be served with the Commission's Orders and with filed testimony, exhibits, pleadings, correspondence, and all other documents submitted by parties.

3. Should AmeriCall file documents of any kind with the Commission in the course of this proceeding, AmeriCall shall also serve a copy of said documents on all other parties of record.
