ORDER

On August 14, 1991, Mo-Tel Cellular, Inc. ("Mo-Tel") filed an application for issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide domestic public cellular radio telecommunications service in Rural Service Area Kentucky 2 -Union, for approval of financing, and for establishment of initial rates.

KRS 278.300(2) requires applications for authority to issue or assume securities or evidence of indebtedness to be ruled on within 60 days unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application. On September 23, 1991, the Commission ordered Mo-Tel to respond to a request for certain information related to its application within 30 days of the Order. A response was filed by Mo-Tel on October 7, 1991, however, the Commission will not have sufficient time to review the information and rule on the application for the Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity before the 60-day period for ruling on the financing portion of the application has expired. Therefore, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue the financing application beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).

The Commission HEREBY ORDERS that the portion of No-Tel's application for approval of initial financing is hereby continued beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).
