ORDER

On August 30, 1991, PC Cellular of Kentucky, L. P. ("PC Cellular") submitted an application with the Commission requesting issuance of a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to operate and construct a cellular telecommunications system, approval of financing, and establishment of initial rates. PC Cellular completed required filing submissions on October 7, 1991.

KRS 278.300(2) requires applications for authority to issue or assume securities or evidence of indebtedness to be ruled on within 60 days unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application.

PC Cellular's filing has generated considerable public comment and requests for intervention. These circumstances will require the Commission to consider this application beyond the 60 day limit of KRS 278.300(2). Therefore, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue the financing application beyond the 60 day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).

Based on the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the portion of PC Cellular's application for authorization to incur indebtedness is hereby continued generally.
