## ORDER

The Commission, on its own motion, hereby initiates this review of the 1991 Integrated Resource Plan of The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") filed on October 14, 1991 pursuant to 807 KAR 5:058. Each utility that files an Integrated Resource Plan is required by 807 KAR 5:058, Section 11, to publish, in a form prescribed by the Commission, notice of its filing in the newspaper of largest circulation in each county in which the utility currently provides service or anticipates to provide service. The notice must be published within 30 days of the filing date of the Integrated Resource Plan. The Commission finds that the following format should be used when publishing notice of the filing of an Integrated Resource Plan:

On (date), (name of utility) filed its 1991 Integrated Resource Plan with the Public Service Commission. This filing includes a 15 year load forecast and a description of the existing and planned conservation programs, load management programs and generating facilities to meet forecasted requirements in a reliable manner at the lowest possible cost. Any interested person may review the plan, submit written questions to the utility, and file written comments on the plan.

Any person interested in participating in the review of this Integrated Resource Plan should within 10 days of the publication of this notice submit a motion to intervene to: Lee M. MacCracken, Executive Director, Public Service Commission, P. O. Box 615, Frankfort, Kentucky 40602.

The newspaper notice should be published one time as soon as reasonably possible after the Integrated Resource Plan is filed. The publication of newspaper notice is in addition to a utility's responsibility under 807 KAR 5:058, Section 2(3), to provide notice, immediately upon filing its initial Integrated Resource Plan, to intervenors in its most recently completed general rate case proceeding, that its plan has been filed and is available from the utility upon request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that ULH&P shall publish the notice set forth above as required by 807 KAR 5:058, Section 11.
