ORDER

Parksville Water District ("Parksville") has submitted a notice of withdrawal of its petition for surcharge. As grounds for its action, Parksville states that it is seeking financing from the Farmers Home Administration for a comprehensive study and rehabilitation of its water distribution system. If these efforts are successful, the proposed surcharge will not be required.

Considering this notice as a motion to withdraw, the Commission finds that the motion should be granted and Parksville permitted to withdraw its petition. The Commission, however, reminds Parksville of its obligation to comply with Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 5(4). If Parksville is unable to comply with this regulation, it should request a deviation.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. Parksville is permitted to withdraw its petition for surcharge.
- 2. This matter is closed and shall be removed from the Commission's docket.
