2. Describe the categories of telephone usage data that you currently maintain.


3. If you do not currently maintain telephone usage data for the residential and business segments of the market, provide an estimate of the cost to do so.

4. Would the information from both line of service data and market segment data provide better statistical information to monitor intraLATA competition? If yes, why? If no, why not?

5. If the answer to Item 4 was no, which type of data would in your opinion be a better indicator of intraLATA competition? Provide rationale.
