ORDER

On August 9, 1991, the Northeast Woodford County Water District ("District") filed a petition for Commission approval of a special contract for a water line extension between the District and Jack Kain, d/b/a the Woodlands ("the Woodlands"). The proposed water extension will provide water service to the residences of a subdivision in Woodford County being developed by the Woodlands.

In response to Commission Order dated November 13, 1991, the District submitted to the Commission on January 15, 1992, an amendment to the contract reflecting that the Woodlands expressly waives its right of reimbursement as provided in 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12(3).

The contract provides that the Woodlands shall construct all required facilities of the extension at no cost or expense to the District. The contract further provides that all facilities installed by the Woodlands shall be deeded by the Woodlands to the District at no cost to the District. Commission Regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12(4), allows a utility to make extensions under different arrangements from those prescribed in the regulations provided such arrangements have been approved by the Commission.

Based upon the foregoing, the Commission finds the contract proposed herein to be reasonable and in the public interest.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the contract between the District and the Woodlands is approved pursuant to 807 KAR 5:066, Section 12(4).
