ORDER

On January 2, 1992, West Oldham Utilities, Inc. ("West Oldham") filed its revised tariff with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of adjusting its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure, KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:067.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

 West Oldham purchases water from Louisville Water Company ("Louisville").

2. Effective January 1, 1992, Louisville increased its rates for water sold to West Oldham from \$1.06 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.10 per 1,000 gallons. There was an increase in the \$255.06 monthly service charge to \$262.86. However, there was no increase in the elevated service area surcharge of \$.19 per 1,000 gallons. Based on 5,000 gallons average monthly usage, the average bi-monthly bill for a West Oldham customer will increase from \$28.76 to \$29.26, which is an increase of 1.74 percent.

3. West Oldham proposed to implement the increased rates to its customers January 1, 1992. Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:067, Section

2(3), an applicant shall not implement the increased rates until the Commission issues an Order authorizing the applicant to adjust its rates. If West Oldham has collected any funds under the increased rates prior to the date of this Order, it should refund to the customers the excess rate charged within 60 days from the date of this Order. KRS 278,190.

4. During the 12 months ending December 31, 1991, West Oldham purchased 57,484,000 gallons of water and sold 52,602,000 gallons.

5. West Oldham's calculations are incorrect, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of 4 cents per 1,000 gallons. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$2,393, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of 5 cents per 1,000 gallons as shown in Appendix B.

6. The purchased water adjustment of 5 cents per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by West Oldham are denied.

2. The purchased water adjustment of 5 cents per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are approved for services rendered on and after the date of this Order.

3. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, West Oldham shall file its revised tariff sheet setting out the rates approved herein.

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4. If West Oldham has collected any funds under the increased rates prior to the date of this Order, it shall refund to the customer the excess rate charged within 60 days from the date of this Order.

5. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, West Oldham shall file a written statement stating whether it charged or collected any funds under the increased rates proposed herein prior to the date of this Order. If excess rates have been charged or collected, the written statement shall include the date the funds were received, the amount charged or collected, and a plan to refund to the customers the excess rate charged within 60 days of the date of this Order.
