On March 6, 1992, Cincinnati Bell Long Distance, Inc. ("CBCD") filed a proposed tariff to offer Perk Plus and Traditional Operator Service. CBCD proposed that the tariff became effective on and after April 5, 1992.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of Traditional Operator Service portion of the tariff filing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:


1. The following pages of the proposed tariff filing be and hereby are suspended for five months from April 5, 1992 up to and including September 4, 1992:


2. Nothing in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
