O R D E R

On November 23, 1992, BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc., d/b/a South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") filed a motion for an extension of time until December 7, 1992 in which to file its comments as directed by the Commission's October 12, 1992 Order. In its motion, South Central Bell also agreed to waive the suspension period, which was to have ended December 30, 1992, until January 13, 1993.

After considering the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. South Central Bell's motion is granted and its comments are now due December 7, 1992.
2. The waiver is hereby accepted and South Central Bell shall not place its tariff into effect until specifically authorized by the Commission.
