IT IS ORDERED that Nolin Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Nolin") shall file the original and 12 copies of the following information with the Commission within 10 days of the date of this Order, with a copy to all parties of record. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible.

- 1. a. State whether Nolin has an internal policy regarding service to mobile homes.
- b. If yes, state this policy. If this policy is written, provide a copy.
 - 2. a. Explain how Nolin defines "mobile home."
- b. Identify all references used or relied upon to establish this definition.

- c. State when Nolin began following this definition.
- d. State whether Nolin has always followed this definition.
- e. If no, state how Nolin previously defined "mobile home."
- 3. Provide all documents, including correspondence and internal memoranda, in which Ms. Shoffner's request for service is discussed.
- 4. a. State whether Nolin has installed electric service to Ms. Shoffner's mobile home since the filing of her complaint.
 - b. If yes, state
- (1) the amount of line required to provide electric service;
- (2) the facilities which had to be installed to provide electric service;
 - (3) total cost of extending service;
 - (4) the amount charged to Ms. Shoffner;
- (5) how the amount charged to Ms. Shoffner was calculated.
- c. If no, describe Nolin's efforts, if any, to provide electric service to Ms. Shoffner's mobile home.
- 5. a. State the number of mobile homes which Nolin currently serves.
- b. State whether any of these mobile homes are moored on permanent foundations.

6. a. State whether Nolin has made an extension of service to a mobile home under arrangements which differ from those set forth in its filed tariff.

b. If yes, state the arrangement and explain the reason for it.
