O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that the Paducah Airport Corporation ("PAC") shall file an original and 10 copies of the following information with the Commission, with a copy to all parties of record. Each item of the data requested should be tabbed and each page of each response appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the person responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to ensure that it is legible. The information requested herein is due no later than September 30, 1992. If the information cannot be provided by this date, PAC should submit a motion for an extension of time stating the reason a delay is necessary and include a date by which the information will be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission.

1. Provide copies of all correspondence with Jackson Purchase Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Jackson Purchase") in which PAC's metering proposal and/or its existing distribution and metering arrangements are discussed.

2. Part V of the complaint at Page 6 refers to single metering that will save PAC approximately \$800 to \$1,000 per month.

a. Explain in detail what PAC means by the term "single metering."

b. Provide the derivation of the \$800 to \$1,000 approximate savings per month. Include all supporting calculations.

3. a. Provide PAC's estimate of the cost to install a master meter through which it would be served by Jackson Purchase. Include all supporting calculations.

b. Describe the physical changes to PAC's existing facilities that would be required in order for PAC to be served by Jackson Purchase through a single meter.

4. PAC's proposal on Page 7 of the complaint, at Paragraph No. 2, states PAC will be billed at the least costly rate under Schedules C, D, and ND.

a. Explain precisely how PAC will be billed under its proposal.

b. State under which rate schedule(s) PAC will be billed under its proposal and explain whether that schedule may vary from month-to-month based on PAC's usage.
