ORDER

On August 24, 1992, Boone County Water and Sewer District '"Boone District") filed a letter requesting Commission review of a proposal for a pilot project involving a joint venture with the Boone County Fiscal Court ("Boone Fiscal Court"). The Boone Fiscal Court has asked Boone District to join in a pilot project in which three areas in Boone District's territory would have water mains extended to them where people have requested them in the past. The Boone Fiscal Court asked Boone District to increase the normal extension policy of contributing 50 feet of the construction cost per customer to 55 feet per customer. The pilot project will serve 103 customers.

Having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that there is sufficient evidence in the record to support a finding that the deviation is reasonable and should be approved. Accordingly, the Commission finds that the proposed contribution of 55 feet should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The extension arrangement proposed by Boone District is approved pursuant to 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11(4).

2. Boone District shall file within 20 days of the date of this Order, a revised tariff provision reflecting the extension arrangement approved herein.
