O R D E R

This matter arising upon request of Communications Gateway Network, Inc. ("CGN") filed October 2, 1992 for confidential protection of Exhibits 4 and 5 to its application on the grounds that exhibits qualify for exemption under KRS 61.878(1)(a), (b), (g), and (h), and it appearing to this Commission as follows:

CGN has applied for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to provide intrastate resold telecommunications services in accordance with its proposed tariff. In support of its application, CGN has filed as Exhibits 4 and 5 financial information required by the Commission pursuant to its Order of May 25, 1984 in Administrative Case No. 273.<sup>1</sup>

The procedure for obtaining confidential protection of information filed with the Commission is provided in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7. That regulation requires any person requesting confidential protection to file a petition setting forth the grounds upon which he relies and attaching a copy of the material

with the information sought to be protected obscured. CGN has not complied with the requirements of the regulation and its request should be denied.

This Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that:


1. The request to protect as confidential Exhibits 4 and 5 to the application of CGN be and is hereby denied.

2. The information sought to be protected shall be held and retained by this Commission as confidential and shall not be open for public inspection for a period of 20 days from the date of this Order to allow CGN to file a petition in accordance with the procedure set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.


3. If at the expiration of the 20-day period CGN has not filed a petition in accordance with the regulation, the information sought to be protected shall be placed in the public record without further Order of the Commission.
