Connect the meter base correctly and it shorted out several of our appliances and kept throwing the breakers. He had to come out again and redo that, but it had already destroyed my refrigerator, but I didn't know it until hours later when it would never keep anything cool again. It worked perfect before the disconnect. Since Clark Rural Electric have installed a new meter we have only used approximately \$250.00 to \$300.00 worth of electricity in 4 months. Before they put a new meter we were using from 150.00 to 450.00 a month (average 300.00 at least) Clark Rural Electric sent out one of their main personall and he went over the house & wiring inside and out and found nothing that could be using as much electricity as they were charging us with.
