ORDER TO SATISFY OR ANSWER





in 1948 and 1949 my father, in order that I have a phone and electricity on the Harry Jones farm, granted Southern Bell and REA an easement to set the required number of poles. To which would be attached the necessary wires to provide the Harry Jones with electricity and phone service. Service was made available to residents at that location until 1991 at which time the telephone company saw fit to remove their wire and consequently service to that location. Since the precedent agreement, it is our opinion that service should be re-stored at the regular cost of normal telephone hook-up. Simply put, if the telephone company (South Central Bell) will honor an existing agreement and provide telephone service to my grandson, Douglas Bostick who currently resides at that location; I then will honor that original agreement or make available the required land on which the necessary cable for continued phone service to the area can be buried. To service all of the residents of that area, this would be any one living in that area at present, the Callahan Farm, Emerson Farm, and Joe Burcham Farm.
