O R D E R

In its final Order entered June 14, 1993, the Commission directed Southern Madison Water District ("Southern Madison") to submit plans for extending service from its water storage tank to the South U.S. Highway 25 area for the purpose of complying with the requirements of the Order of August 14, 1986 in Case No. 9596.¹ Southern Madison has filed a motion for a 30-day extension of time until October 12, 1993 in which to comply with that Order.

After considering the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that Southern Madison's motion is granted and its plans for extending service to the South U.S. Highway 25 area are now due October 12, 1993.
