O R D E R

On July 29, 1992, GTE South Incorporated ("GTE South") made a tariff filing to reduce its charge for non-traffic sensitive revenue requirement recovery. On August 24, 1992, the Commission entered an Order which allowed the tariff filing to become effective as proposed. The Commission also invited affected persons to comment on the impact of the tariff filing relative to specific issues.

AT&T of the South Central States, Inc. ("AT&T"); BellSouth Telecommunications, Inc. d/b/a South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell"); and Advanced Telecommunications Corporation d/b/a ATC Long Distance filed for and were granted intervention in this proceeding. Only AT&T filed written comments, none of which objected to GTE South's tariff filing.


On September 30, 1992, GTE South filed a motion to close this proceeding. On October 6, 1992, South Central Bell filed a response in support of the motion. On February 24, 1993, an informal conference was held to discuss issues relevant to this proceeding with the parties of record in the absence of substantial written comments.

The Commission finds that all affected persons have had ample opportunity to comment on the impact of GTE South's tariff filing and none raised any objection or sought any relief. Consequently, good cause exists to grant GTE South's motion.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this proceeding be and it hereby is closed.
