ORDER

On March 31, 1993, Western Kentucky Gas Company filed an application with the Commission wherein it proposes to revise its Gas Cost Adjustment Clause, curtailment plan, and large volume transportation tariffs effective May 1, 1993.

The Commission finds that, pursuant to KRS 278.190, further proceedings are necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariffs and that such proceedings cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The proposed tariffs are hereby suspended for 5 months from May 1, 1993 up to and including September 30, 1993.
- 2. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering a final decision in this case prior to the termination of the suspension period.
