On May 21, 1993, Brandenburg Telephone Company ("Brandenburg") filed motions requesting an extension of time in which to respond to the Commission's May 4, 1993 Order and further requesting relief from answering Item 21 of that same Order. However, the Commission reminds Brandenburg that its decision regarding Brandenburg's rate of return, as well as all other issues, will be based on the record as it stands at the conclusion of these proceedings.

After considering the motions and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Brandenburg's motion for extension is granted and its response to the Commission's May 4, 1993 Order is now due July 6, 1993.

2. Brandenburg's motion for relief from answering Item 21 of the Commission's May 4, 1993 Order is granted.
