ORDER

This matter arising upon request of Professional Communications Management Services, Inc. d/b/a PROCOM ("PROCOM") filed March 1, 1993 for confidential protection of its balance sheet and profit and loss statement filed in support of its application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity on the grounds that the information sought to be protected is proprietary, and it appearing to this Commission as follows:

PROCOM has applied for authority to operate as a reseller of interexchange services. In support of its application, PROCOM has submitted the balance sheet and the profit and loss statement which it seeks to protect as confidential.

The procedure for obtaining confidential protection of information filed with the Commission is provided in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7. That regulation requires anyone requesting confidential protection to file a petition setting forth the grounds upon which it relies and attaching a copy of the information to be protected which identifies the confidential material. PROCOM has not

complied with these requirements or any of the requirements of the regulation and its request cannot be granted.

This Commission being otherwise sufficiently advised,

IT IS ORDERED that:

- 1. The request to protect as confidential the balance sheet and the profit and loss statement filed as a part of PROCOM's application be and is hereby denied.
- 2. The information sought to be protected shall be held and retained by this Commission as confidential and shall not be open for public inspection for a period of 20 days from the date of this Order to allow PROCOM to file a petition in accordance with the procedure set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, Section 7.
- 3. If at the expiration of the 20-day period PROCOM has not filed a petition in accordance with the regulation, the information sought to be protected shall be placed in the public record without further Order of the Commission.
