O R D E R


On February 12, 1993, GTE South Incorporated ("GTE") filed a proposed tariff to establish rates and charges for GTE Local Calling Plans. Upon implementation of the filing, all business and residence one-party and PBX customers in the exchanges of Lexington, Nicholasville, Versailles and Wilmore would be required to choose one of the following calling plans: Community Plus, Basic Calling or Premium Calling. GTE proposed that the tariff filing become effective on and after January 10, 1994.


After consideration of the proposed filing and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that further proceedings are necessary to complete its review.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case be and it hereby is established for the purpose of reviewing GTE's proposed tariff filing to establish rates and charges for local calling plans.
