O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Elk Lake Water Company ("Elk Lake") shall file the original and 12 copies of the following information with the Commission with a copy to all parties of record no later than 10 days from the date of this order. If the information cannot be provided by this date, a motion for an extension of time must be submitted stating the reason for the delay and the date by which the information can be furnished. Such motion will be considered by the Commission. Elk Lake shall furnish with each response the name of the witness who will be available to respond to questions concerning each item of information requested should a public hearing be scheduled.

1. In table 10 of the application, the number listed for unmetered water revenues is \$7000. How is this number determined?

2. In table 10 of the application, the number listed for estimated existing water sales is \$75,991. How is this number determined?

3. In table 10 of the application, a proposed operating budget is shown. Are the availability fees collected by the

association included in this table? If so, for what amount and where are they listed?

4. Which of the following rate schedules is currently in effect?

I.	First 2,000 gallons	\$19.70 Minimum Bill
	Next 2,000 gallons	4.40 Per 1,000 gallons
	Over 4,000 gallons	1.60 Per 1,000 gallons
II.	First 2,000 gallons	\$19.70 Minimum Bill
	Next 2,000 gallons	2.20 Per 1,000 Gallons
	Over 4,000 gallons	1.60 Per 1,000 Gallons

5. Has the correct above rate schedule been in effect since April 1, 1992? If not, explain.

6. Association billing records for September 1992 through August 1993 were submitted to PSC Staff for review. Those records indicate Rate Schedule I was charged for September and October of 1992, while Rate Schedule II was charged for November 1992 through August 1993. Explain.

7. Have the availability fees been collected each month beginning with April of 1992? If not, explain.

8. The submitted records seem to indicate that an availability fee was not collected in September 1992. Explain.
