ORDER TO SATISFY OR ANSWER




Should documents of any kind be filed with the Commission in the course of this proceeding, the documents shall also be served on all parties of record.

Comer Walter Callahan and for his complaint set out herein as follows.  
Walter Callahan has had a meter with Ill. power co. near castle
