ORDER

7, 1993, Christian County Water On October District ("Christian County") filed a complaint against South Hopkins Water District ("South Hopkins") alleging that it was serving Wayne Hamby and Bob Hamby, who reside in Christian County's service area, in contravention of Case No. 90-220.1 At an informal conference among the parties and Commission Staff, Christian County affirmed that it was able to serve these customers, had given South Hopkins notice of that fact, and wanted the Commission to order South Hopkins to cease service. Based on these assertions, the Commission ordered South Hopkins to cease service. South Hopkins has notified Bob Hamby that his service will be terminated. Wayne Hamby has apparently moved from the area.

Case No. 90-220, Christian County Water District's Proposed Extension to Collins Branch Road and the Provision of Service to Certain Customers who are Currently Served by South Hopkins Water District.

Bob Hamby contacted Commission Staff on January 5, 1994. He is concerned that Christian County cannot serve him unless new lines are constructed. He states the line through which he received service from Christian County was removed because it was situated on the property of a neighbor who requested that it be removed. The Commission therefore finds that provisions of its December 22, 1993 Order should be held in abeyance until it can investigate whether Christian County is ready, willing, and able to serve Bob Hamby according to the terms of Case No. 90-220, this case, and all other applicable law.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. South Hopkins continue to serve Bob Hamby until the Commission orders it to cease service.
- 2. A representative from Christian County and a representative of South Hopkins be present at Bob Hamby's residence, located at 325 McKnight Road, St. Charles, Kentucky, at 10:30 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, on January 19, 1994 to meet with the Hambys and Commission Staff about the service and meter location issues.
