ORDER

On December 27, 1993, the Commission received a complaint from William Henson Leach regarding his electric service from Harrison County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Harrison RECC"). On January 25, 1994, the Commission by Order required Harrison RECC to satisfy or answer the complaint. Harrison RECC responded on February 2, 1994. On April 26, 1994, the Commission entered an Order for Harrison RECC to respond to data requests. Those responses were filed on May 12, 1994.

Harrison RECC, having answered the complaint of William Henson Leach and it appearing that issues of law and fact are in dispute, the Commission finds that a formal hearing in this matter should be held and a procedural schedule should be established.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A formal hearing in this matter shall be held on September 20, 1994, at 9:00 a.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky, and continue until completed.

2. Because it is a corporation, Harrison RECC shall be represented by counsel at the formal hearing.

3. Each party may, on or before July 15, 1994, serve upon any other party a request for production of documents and written interrogatories to be answered by the party served within 10 days of service.

4. Each party may, on or before August 1, 1994, serve upon any other party a supplemental request for production of documents and supplemental written interrogatories to be answered by the party served within 10 days of service.

5. Each party shall, on or before August 25, 1994, serve upon the other parties a written summary of the testimony of those witnesses which it expects to call at the formal hearing, copies of all exhibits to be introduced at that hearing, and all preliminary motions and objections, except objections to exhibits. All exhibits shall be appropriately marked.

6. Copies of all documents served upon any party shall be served on all other parties and filed with the Commission.

7. Any request to reschedule the hearing is to be made in writing and filed at least two business days prior to the date of the scheduled hearing.
