- 4. The filed testimony of Roger L. Peterman is hereby accepted and made a part of the record of the September 13, 1994 hearing.
- 5. At the close of the hearing, closing statements, not exceeding 15 minutes in length, may be made in the following order: Kenton County Water District No. 1, Boone District, Florence, Ludlow, Taylor Mill, and Walton.
- 6. Nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
