O R D E R

On March 14, 1994, Lexington-South Elkhorn Water District ("LSEWD") filed with the Commission an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct facilities which would enable it to receive its water supply from the city of Nicholasville. LSEWD currently receives its water supply from Kentucky-American Water Company ("Kentucky-American") located in Lexington, Kentucky. Kentucky-American was made a party to this case on May 8, 1994. The city of Nicholasville was granted intervention on May 2, 1994.

Commission Staff requested additional information from LSEWD at an informal conference held among the parties and staff on April 28, 1994. That information was filed with the Commission May 20, 1994. Commission Staff has reviewed the information supplied by LSEWD and believes the case can be submitted to the Commission for decision.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case will stand submitted to the Commission for a final determination unless any party requests,

in writing, a public hearing within 14 days from the date of this Order.
