O R D E R

On October 14, 1994, Lexington-South Elkhorn Water District ("Lexington-South Elkhorn") filed a motion to withdraw its application for authority to construct facilities necessary to purchase potable water from the city of Nicholasville, Kentucky ("Nicholasville"). The basis for the motion is the refusal by Nicholasville to provide information necessary to support the application. Absent the ability to purchase water from Nicholasville, Lexington-South Elkhorn states that it will continue purchasing water pursuant to a contract with Kentucky-American Water Company.

Based on the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause to allow the pending application to be withdrawn.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Lexington-South Elkhorn for a certificate of convenience and necessity be and it hereby is withdrawn and this case shall be closed.
