O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Metropolitan Fiber Systems of Kentucky, Inc. ("Metropolitan Fiber") shall file the original and ten copies of the following information with the Commission no later than 30 days from the date of this Order.

1. On page 4, paragraph 6, of its application filed March 4, 1994, Metropolitan Fiber states that it intends to construct facilities in Kentucky immediately adjacent to the Cincinnati, Ohio metropolitan area. However, on page 9, paragraph 11, of the application and pages 1 and 2 of its April 21, 1994 filing, Metropolitan Fiber describes its initial service territory to be in the Louisville and Jefferson County area. Clarify the initial geographic service area which Metropolitan Fiber intends to serve.

2. In its application, Metropolitan Fiber states that it will not provide local exchange service. What physical limitations of Metropolitan Fiber's proposed network will ensure that local exchange service will not be provided? If there are no physical limitations, what steps will Metropolitan Fiber take to prevent end users from using its network for local exchange service?


3. Provide examples of Metropolitan Fiber's marketing material to be distributed to prospective customers.
