ORDER

On June 21, 1994, the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, by and through his Utility and Rate Intervention Division ("Attorney General"), filed a motion to reconsider the recently entered procedural schedule. The Attorney General requests that the procedural schedule be amended to include a provision for supplemental intervenor requests for information. In support of his motion, the Attorney General states that the supplemental intervenor request for information will enable the intervenors to be better prepared for the case, create a better record, and reduce the length of the public hearing.

However, the procedural schedule as entered on June 16, 1994 grants adequate opportunity to Intervenors for discovery and provides for a public hearing. An additional intervenor request for information will serve only to delay this proceeding. The Commission, having considered this motion and having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the Attorney General's motion to reconsider and amend the procedural schedule is denied.
