South Central continued to let him use, charging it to my account, as well as his last bill owed. Stating I could file criminal charges.

I have tried since October of 1991 to resolve this. I even called South Central Bell to cancel Mr. Lathrop calling card and they wouldn't let me. South Central Bell policy is to cancel and make all cards void when services are disconnected. I shouldn't have to pay for someone else's calling cards or even their final bill. I even had to have the number changed to cancel card. I have already paid more than half of those bills not belonging to me. Thru Nov 1991 thru June of 1993 to resolve this. In June of 1993 I thought I had finally resolved this and got the credit I deserved, but to my surprise my services were turned off for non-full-payment due. If South Central Bell would check their records, they would find that I always paid my bills in full on time except for Mr. Lathrop's charges.

I have been in contact with Mary Porter of South Central Bell numerous times, she states that no matter what my last bill was due in June 1993 and my services were

turned off because of final bill owed. When I talked to Ms. Porter she stated that she can't go back to verify old bills. This is also not true. Please help me to resolve this, because I myself can not get any where with Ms. Porter, even going to her office in person a few weeks ago did no good. She refused to see me.
