O R D E R

By letter dated June 13, 1994, Bath County Water District ("Bath County") requests permission to deviate from its normal extension policy. Specifically, it requests Commission approval to extend a water line a distance of 2,200 feet with the customer providing only the cost of labor.

Bath County has no extension policy contained in its tariff; therefore, Commission regulation 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11(10), permitting a utility to extend its existing distribution main a distance of 50 feet or less without charge to the customer is applicable.


The Commission, having considered Bath County's request finds no reason to deviate from its extension regulation and being further sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that Bath County's request to deviate from 807 KAR 5:066, Section 11(1), is denied.


