ORDER

On July 29, 1994, Integrated Teletechnologies, Inc. ("Integrated Teletechnologies") filed an application with the Commission seeking a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. Integrated Teletechnologies responded to the Commission's Order, dated September 8, 1994, requesting additional information on September 23, 1994.

Integrated Teletechnologies is a Delaware corporation with its principal offices in the state of New York and intends to resell tariffed services of facilities-based carriers certified by this Commission. Integrated Teletechnologies does not request authority to provide operator-assisted telecommunications services.

Integrated Teletechnologies does not own or operate, nor does it intend to construct, any telecommunications transmission facilities within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. All intrastate telecommunications transmission services will be provided by an underlying carrier certified by this Commission. The application provided by Integrated Teletechnologies demonstrates its financial, managerial, and technical capability to provide utility service. The Commission finds that Integrated Teletechnologies should be authorized to resell intrastate longdistance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky. The Commission further finds that the rates proposed by Integrated Teletechnologies on July 29, 1994 should be approved as the fair, just, and reasonable rates to be charged.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. Integrated Teletechnologies be and it hereby is granted authority to resell intrastate long-distance telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Kentucky on and after the date of this Order.

2. Integrated Teletechnologies' authority to provide service is strictly limited to those services described in this Order and Integrated Teletechnologies' application.

3. IntraLATA services shall be provided in accordance with the restrictions and conditions of service contained in Administrative Case No. 323.¹

The rates proposed by Integrated Teletechnologies on July
29, 1994 are hereby approved.

5. Within 30 days from the date of this Order, Integrated Teletechnologies shall file, pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, its July 29, 1994 tariff sheets without modifications and which conform to the restrictions and conditions of service contained herein.
