O R D E R

On November 28, 1994, Salt River Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Salt River") filed a motion for an extension of time in which to respond to the Commission's November 16, 1994 Order.

KRS 278.300(2) requires applications for authority to issue or assume securities or evidences of indebtedness to be ruled on within 60 days unless it is necessary for good cause to continue the application. Granting Salt River's motion for an extension will not allow the Commission adequate time in which to obtain and review the information prior to the expiration of the 60-day period in which the Commission must rule on the financing application. Therefore, the Commission finds that good cause exists to continue the financing application beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).


After consideration of the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Salt River's motion for an extension of time to December 2, 1994 in which to respond to the Commission's November 16, 1994 Order is granted.

2. The portion of Salt River's application for authorization to incur additional indebtedness is continued beyond the 60-day period specified in KRS 278.300(2).
