On October 18, 1994, Jackson County Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Jackson County") filed a notice of intent to file a rate application and requested authority to use an abbreviated form of newspaper notice to notify its customers of its proposed rates.

Based on the letter and being advised, the Commission finds that Jackson County has provided no information to demonstrate that publishing notice of all proposed rate changes would be either voluminous or unduly expensive.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Jackson County's request to use an abbreviated form of newspaper notice be and it hereby is denied.

On October 13, 1994, the Commission issued an Order directing Jonathan Creek Water District ("Jonathan Creek") to appear at a hearing scheduled for November 15, 1994 and be prepared to show cause why Jonathan Creek should not be penalized pursuant to KRS 278.990 for probable violation of KRS 278.020(1).

Commission Staff and Jonathan Creek are currently attempting to negotiate a settlement in this matter. The Commission therefore finds that the hearing scheduled for November 15, 1994 should be cancelled pending the outcome of these discussions.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing scheduled for November 15, 1994 is cancelled, to be rescheduled at a later date if necessary.
