O R D E R

On December 1, 1994, Nebo Water District ("Nebo") filed its application with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") for the purpose of adjusting its rates pursuant to the purchased water adjustment procedure. KRS 278.015 and 807 KAR 5:068.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being otherwise sufficiently advised, finds that:

1. Nebo purchases water from the City of Madisonville ("Madisonville").
2. Madisonville increased its rates for water sold from \$1.54 per 1,000 gallons to \$1.61 per 1,000 gallons effective January 1, 1995. Nebo proposes to increase the water rates to its customers effective January 1, 1995.
3. During the 12 months ending October 31, 1994, Nebo purchased 95,305,000 gallons of water and sold 81,041,000 gallons. The increase in the cost of purchased water is \$6,671.35, resulting in a purchased water adjustment of 8 cents per 1,000 gallons as shown in Appendix B. Based on an average monthly usage of 5,000 gallons, monthly bills to Nebo's customers will increase 40 cents from \$24.40 to \$24.80, an increase of 1.6 percent.

4. Nebo has miscalculated the rates; therefore, the rates proposed by Nebo should be denied.

5. The purchased water adjustment of 8 cents per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A, attached hereto and incorporated herein, are fair, just, and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The rates proposed by Nebo are hereby denied.


2. The purchased water adjustment of 8 cents per 1,000 gallons and the rates in Appendix A are approved for services rendered on and after January 1, 1995.

3. Within 30 days of the date of this Order, Nebo shall file revised tariffs setting out the rates approved herein.

4. Within 20 days of the date of this Order, Nebo shall file verification that the notice to its customers has been given.

APPENDIX TO AN ORDER OF THE KENTUCKY PUBLIC SERVICE  
COMMISSION IN CASE NO. 94-488 DATED DECEMBER 19, 1994

The following rates and charges are prescribed for the customers in the area served by Nebo Water District. All other rates and charges not specifically mentioned herein shall remain the same as those in effect under authority of this Commission prior to the effective date of this Order.

MINIMUM WATER RATES BASED ON SIZE CONNECTIONS:

<u>Size of Water Meter Connection</u>	<u>Number Gallons or Less of Water Per Month to be Provided for the Minimum Rate</u>	<u>Minimum Monthly Water Rate Per Connection</u>
5/8 x 3/4 inch	2,000 gallons	\$ 10.92
1 inch	4,000 gallons	20.84
1-1/2 inch	10,000 gallons	44.60
2 inch	20,000 gallons	79.20
3 inch	30,000 gallons	108.80

METER RATES FOR WATER USAGE IN ADDITION TO MINIMUM CHARGE:

Subject to the minimum monthly water rate specified above, the following metered charges shall be made for water consumption per month to customers of all size connections:

<u>Number of Gallons of Water Per Month</u>	<u>Monthly Charge</u>
First 2,000 gallons	\$10.92 Minimum Charge
Next 2,000 gallons	4.96 per 1,000 gallons
Next 6,000 gallons	3.96 per 1,000 gallons
Next 10,000 gallons	3.46 per 1,000 gallons
Over 20,000 gallons	2.96 per 1,000 gallons

PURCHASED WATER ADJUSTMENT CALCULATIONS

Water Purchased: 95,305,000 gallons  
Water Sold: 81,041,000 gallons

Cost at Changed Rate:

95,305,000 x \$1.61 = \$153,441.05

LESS

Cost at Base Rate:

95,305,000 x \$1.54 = \$146,769.70

Increase in Cost: \$ 6,671.35

\$6,671.35 + 81,041,000 gallons sold = \$.082 cents or  
\$0.08/1,000 gallons
