O R D E R

The Commission required BellSouth Telecommunications Corporation d/b/a South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") to file data gathered from its Area Calling Service ("ACS") exchanges to demonstrate the accuracy of its projections and the reasonableness of the ACS rates. South Central Bell filed this information on December 1, 1994. The Commission has reviewed this information and accepts South Central Bell's analyses at this time. Thus, the existing rate structure and the rate levels for ACS should not be changed. South Central Bell should file a similar analysis on December 1, 1995 and should include a description of the business "take rate," that is, an explanation for why business customers have not migrated to ACS.

The Commission, having reviewed the December 1, 1994 filing and having been otherwise sufficiently advised, HEREBY ORDERS that:

1. South Central Bell's filing shall be accepted.
2. South Central Bell shall file a similar analysis on December 1, 1995.


3. The 1995 analysis shall include a description and explanation of the business penetration rate for ACS.
