Contel Cellular of Kentucky, Inc., which does business as Cellular One, has applied to the Public Service Commission of Kentucky for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and operate a new cell facility to provide cellular radio telecommunication service. The facility will include a 125' monopole with attached antennas extending upwards for a total height of 139' and an equipment shelter to be located at 512-R Lyndon Lane, Louisville, Jefferson County, Kentucky. A map showing the location of the proposed new cell facility is enclosed. This notice is being sent to you because you own property or reside within a 500' radius of the proposed monopole.

The Commission invites your comments regarding the proposed construction. You also have the right to intervene in this matter. Your initial communication to the Commission must be received by the Commission within 20 days of the date of this letter as shown above.
