## ORDER

On October 11, 1995, the City of Pikeville ("the City"), by counsel, filed a motion requesting an extension of time until October 16, 1995 in which to respond to the interrogatories and requests for production of documents propounded to it by Mountain Water District ("Mountain"). After considering the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds good cause exists to grant the City's motion. The Commission further finds that granting the City's motion necessitates adjusting the procedural schedule set forth in the Commission's September 15, 1995 Order.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

- 1. The City's motion is granted and its response to Mountain's interrogatories and requests for production of documents is now due October 16, 1995.
- 2. The procedural schedule set forth in the Commission's September 15, 1995 Order is amended as follows:

Each party may, on or before October 25, 1995, serve upon the other party a supplemental request for production of documents and supplemental written interrogatories to be answered by the party within 7 days of service.

Each party shall, on or before November 8, 1995, serve upon the other party a written summary of the testimony of the witnesses which are expected to be called at the formal hearing, copies of all exhibits which will be used at the hearing regardless of whether they are to be introduced, and all preliminary motions and objections, except objections to exhibits. All exhibits shall be appropriately marked.
