
Should documents of any kind be filed with the Commission in the course of this proceeding, the documents shall also be served on all parties of record.







The following people are witnesses and will verify that Adrian Amourque did not have power in his trailer at Feltrero Trailer Park the month of February until the 16th of March 1995, due to damage to trailer by the moving company.

The trailer had no furnace hook ups or wiring. Wiring had to be redone through the trailer to breaker box. Plumbing had to be redone and furnace vents had to be fixed due to the accident under the trailer. Power was not hooked up until these things were completed.

Power was used by extension cord from Gat #20 (D.S. Miniard)

They used a kerosene heater and space heater during this process.

They were living in Knott County through March 16 until trailer was completed.
