O R D E R

On July 28, 1995, Jeffrey David Evans filed a complaint against Rattlesnake Ridge Water District ("Rattlesnake Ridge") concerning water service to his property. Rattlesnake Ridge was directed by Order to Satisfy or Answer the Complaint. Although Rattlesnake Ridge's answer, filed on September 13, 1995, alleged to have satisfied the Complaint, Mr. Evans informed the Commission that in fact the Complaint has not been satisfied. Although both parties responded to an information request from the Commission, it appears further proceedings will be necessary in this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Each party may, on or before December 29, 1995, serve upon any other party a request for production of documents and written interrogatories to be answered by the party served within 14 days of service.

2. Each party may, on or before January 19, 1996, serve upon the other party a supplemental request for production of documents

and supplemental written interrogatories to be answered by the party served within 7 days of service.

3. Each party shall, on or before February 2, 1996, serve upon the other parties a written summary of the testimony of the witnesses which are expected to be called at the formal hearing, copies of all exhibits which will be used at the hearing regardless of whether they are to be introduced, and all preliminary motions and objections, except objections to exhibits. All exhibits shall be appropriately marked.

4. Copies of all documents served upon any party shall be served upon all other parties and simultaneously filed with the Commission.

5. A formal hearing in this matter shall be held on February 6, 1996, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky.
