O R D E R

The Union Light, Heat and Power Company ("ULH&P") having answered the complaint of Carrie Fryman and it appearing that issues of law and fact are in dispute, the Commission finds that a formal hearing in this matter should be held and a procedural schedule should be established.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. A formal hearing in this matter shall be held on February 7, 1996, at 10:00 a.m., Eastern Standard Time, in Hearing Room 1 of the Commission's offices at 730 Schenkel Lane, Frankfort, Kentucky, and continuing until completed.

2. Each party may, on or before December 7, 1995 serve upon any other party a request for production of documents and written interrogatories to be answered by the party served within 15 days of service.

3. Each party may, on or before January 12, 1996, take the testimony of any person by deposition upon oral examination pursuant to notice or by agreement.

4. Each party may, on or before January 12, 1996, serve upon any other party a written request for admission, for purposes of this proceeding only, of the truth of any matter relevant to this proceeding set forth in the request that relate to statements or opinions of fact or of the application of law to fact. The matter is admitted unless, within 10 days after service of the request, the party to whom the request is directed serves upon the party requesting the admission a written answer or objection. The form of the request for admission and the answer or objection thereto shall otherwise be governed by Kentucky Civil Rule 36.

5. Each party shall, on or before January 30, 1996, serve upon the other parties a written summary of the testimony of those witnesses which it expects to call at the formal hearing, copies of all exhibits to be introduced at that hearing, and all preliminary motions and objections, except objections to exhibits. All exhibits shall be appropriately marked.

6. Copies of all documents served upon any party shall be served on all other parties and filed with the Commission.
