ORDER

On December 1, 1995, the Commission approved The Union Light, Heat and Power Company's ("ULH&P") demand-side management ("DSM") plan. The DSM plan included the implementation of specific DSM programs, a collaborative process to consider and develop additional DSM programs, and tariffs which would permit ULH&P to recover DSM program and administrative costs, lost revenues, and incentives. The DSM plan will be in effect through December 31, 1999.

On September 30, 1996, ULH&P filed a motion for the Commission to establish February 1, 1997 as the date for ULH&P to file its 1997 Annual Demand-Side Management Cost Recovery Mechanism Adjustment. ULH&P's approved DSM plan originally specified October 1, 1996 as the filing date of the annual cost recovery adjustment. In its motion, ULH&P stated that the DSM tariffs have been in place less than six months and that the DSM Collaborative is still in the planning process for additional DSM programs. ULH&P

contends that waiting until February 1, 1997 will allow time for additional program development, development of a more specific budget, and more experience with DSM programs. Having considered the motion and being otherwise sufficiently advised, the Commission finds that ULH&P's motion should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that ULH&P shall file on or before February 1, 1997 its 1997 Annual Demand-Side Management Cost Recovery Mechanism Adjustment.
