O R D E R

On October 14, 1996, the Commission granted Defendants' motion to hold this matter in abeyance for an additional 30 days to permit the parties to conclude their negotiations. The Commission further ordered each party to advise the Commission in writing of the status of the negotiations no later than November 4, 1996. Neither party has advised the Commission of the status of the negotiations nor otherwise complied with the established procedural schedule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, each party shall show cause in writing why it should not be subject to civil penalty or other administrative sanction for its failure to comply with the Commission's Orders.

2. Within 10 days of the date of this Order, each party shall show cause in writing why this matter should not be set for hearing and a procedural schedule established.
